- **Laryngology:** Voice and swallowing disorders, airway interventions, and diagnostic laryngeal endoscopy.
- **General & Pediatric ENT:** Routine surgical interventions including **tonsillectomy, adenoidectomy**, and management of common childhood ENT disorders.
- **Head & Neck Oncosurgery:** Comprehensive management, screening, and surgical intervention for thyroid, salivary gland, and head and neck cancers.
- **Emergency Care:** 24/7 prompt management of ENT emergencies, including foreign body removal from the ear, nose, and esophagus.

The department is equipped with state-of-the-art diagnostic and surgical technologies to ensure patient safety and precision:

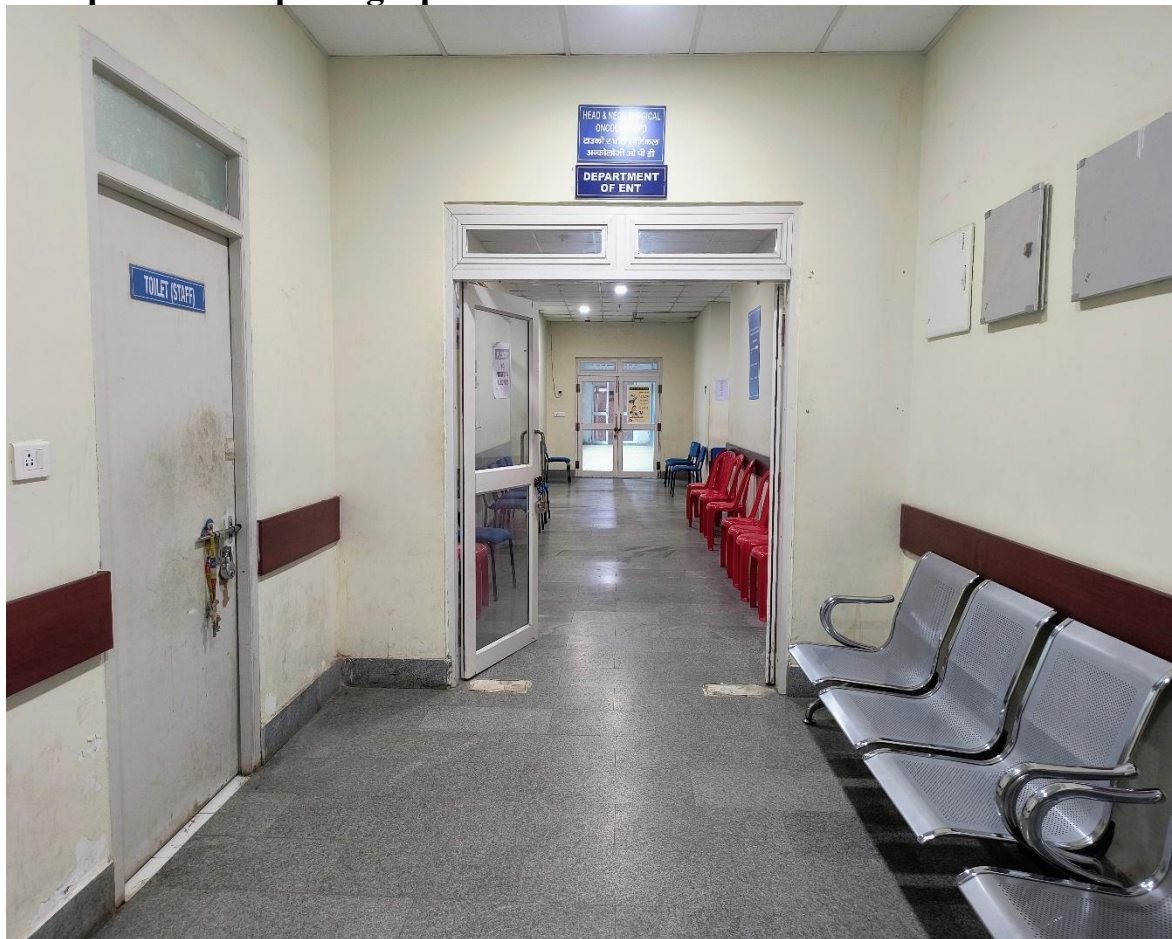
- **Surgical Microscopes:** Zeiss S8 & S7 (Major OT), Leica (Minor OT)
