- The Department of General Medicine at HLSGMC, established in 2026 is a major clinical department providing comprehensive medical care, undergraduate training, research, and community health services. The department functions as a Tertiary Care Referral Centre delivering evidence-based management of adult medical illnesses while following the Competency-Based Medical Education (CBME) curriculum. Teaching is conducted during Phase II, Phase III Part I, and Phase III Part II, integrating lectures, practical sessions, and clinical postings.

The major areas of clinical services include:

- Outpatient (OPD), Inpatient (IPD), Emergency and Critical Care Services.
 - Management of Cardiovascular, Respiratory, Gastrointestinal, Endocrine, Renal, Neurological, Infectious, Rheumatological, and Metabolic Disorders.
 - Diagnostic evaluation and multidisciplinary patient care.
 - Preventive healthcare, patient counselling and follow-up care.
 - Referral and collaborative care with Super-Specialty Departments.
