1.Department Overview

The Department of Ophthalmology provides comprehensive outpatient, inpatient, surgical and community -based eye care services. 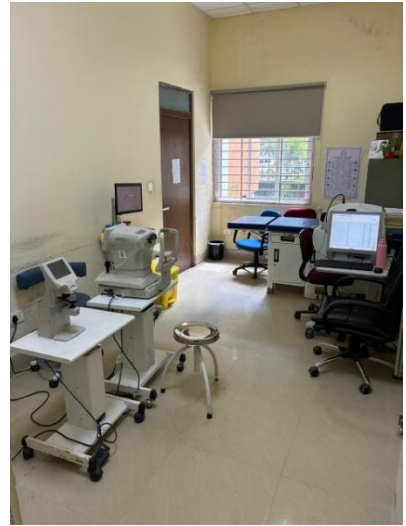
