Department Overview

The Department of Orthopaedics provides comprehensive, patient-centred care for musculoskeletal conditions, including trauma, fractures and dislocations, arthritis, sports injuries, hand and upper-limb disorders, paediatric orthopaedics and other orthopaedic problems. The department provides outpatient, inpatient, emergency and operative services, with specialist clinics and multidisciplinary care. Major services include fracture and dislocation management, trauma surgery, joint replacement and reconstruction, hand surgery, sports injury and arthroscopy services, paediatric orthopaedics and rehabilitation. The department is committed to safe, evidence-based clinical care, early mobilization and functional recovery. Undergraduate teaching and structured clinical training is being developed as part of the medical college curriculum.

Services Provided

- Emergency and trauma care, including fractures, dislocations and acute musculoskeletal injuries
- General orthopaedic outpatient and inpatient services
- Operative management of orthopaedic trauma and reconstructive conditions
- Joint replacement and management of degenerative joint disease, as available
- Hand and upper-limb surgery and management of hand injuries
- Sports injury and musculoskeletal rehabilitation services
- Paediatric orthopaedic assessment and management, as available
- Post-operative rehabilitation and functional recovery
- Undergraduate (MBBS) teaching and clinical training

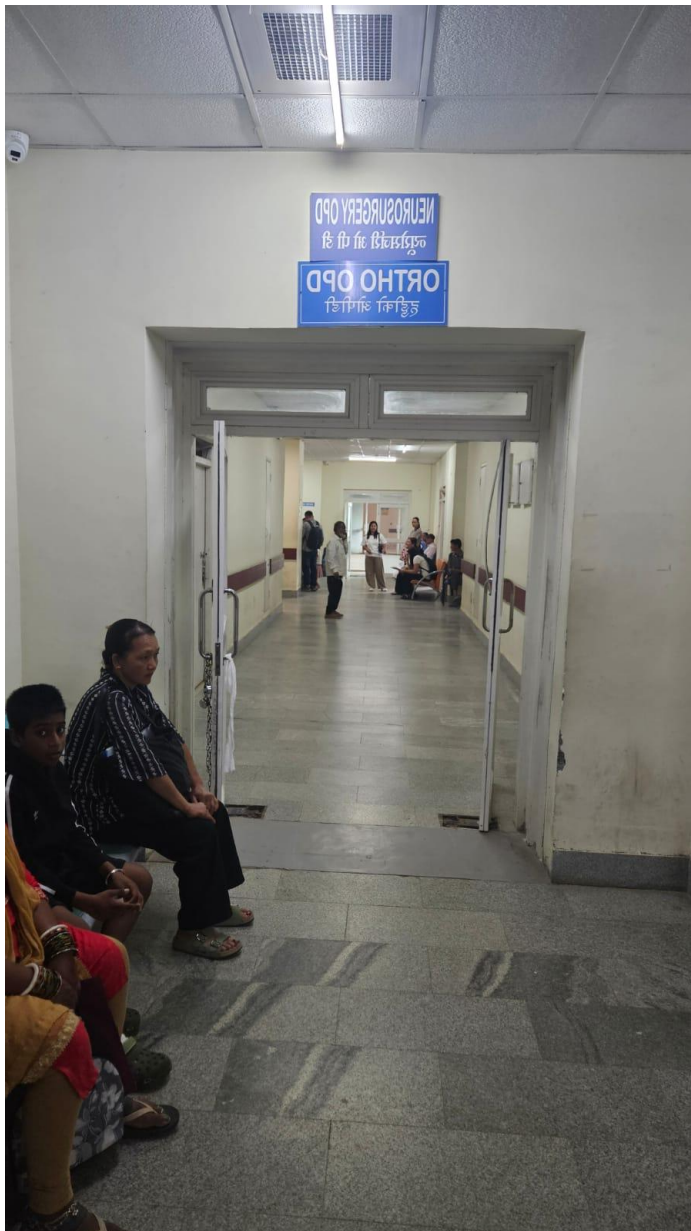
